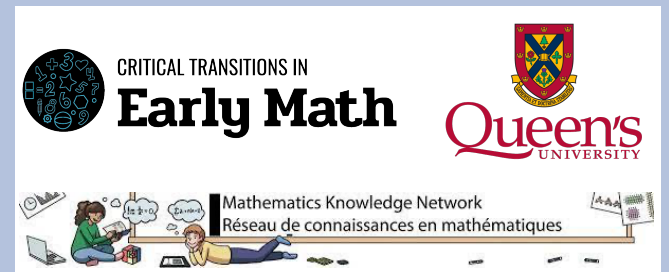
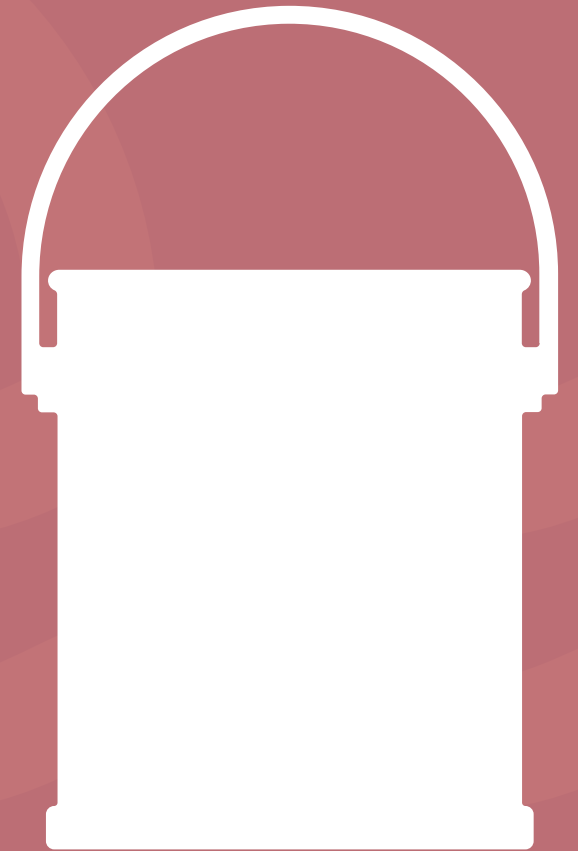


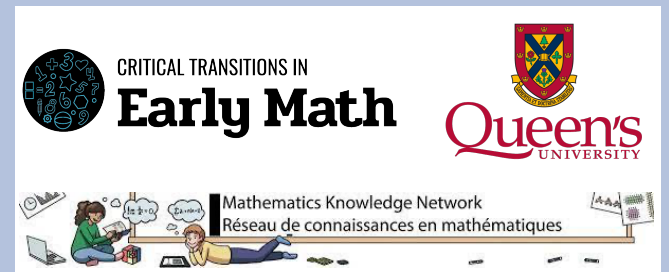
Math at the Beach



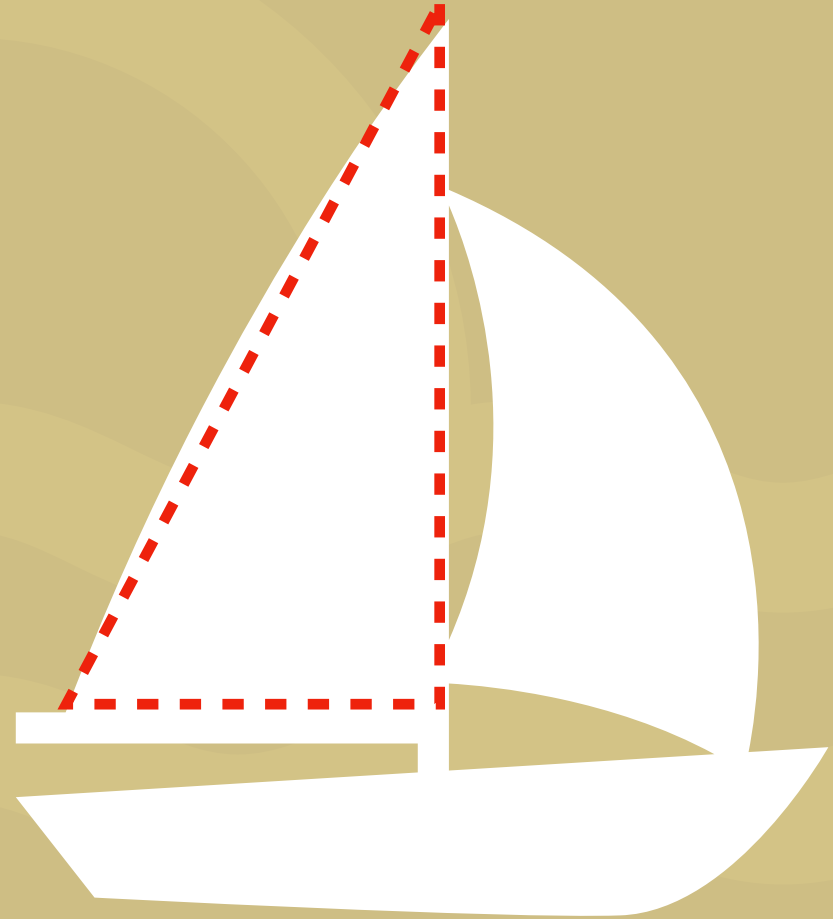

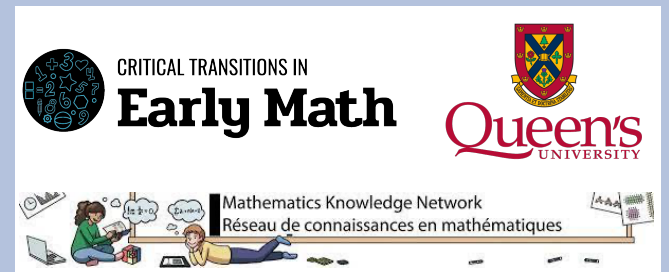
Math at the Beach



Take some time to talk about what shapes you can find at the beach. How many different shapes can you identify?



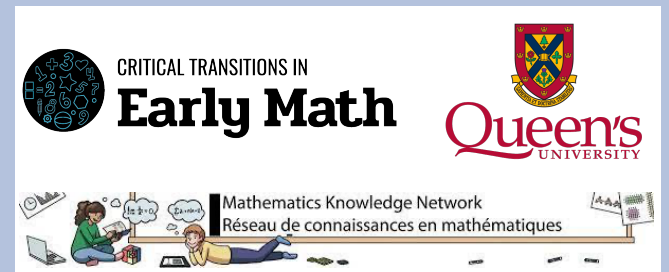
Math at the Beach
